## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Trousers	plain grey school trousers
Skirts/dresses	plain grey school skirts or pinafore dresses or blue and white check summer dresses
Polo shirt	white with school logo or plain
Sweatshirt	navy with school logo or plain
Socks/Tights	plain grey/black/white
Footwear	should be plain <b>black</b> school-type shoes. No stripes, coloured flashes or heels. <b>No trainers.</b> Boots may be worn to travel to
	school and then shoes worn for the day.





Jewellery	is not permitted apart from stud earrings. Children must be able to tape up or remove their own earrings for PE for health and safety reasons.
Make-up	it is not necessary for children to wear make-up.
Hair	hairstyles must not be extreme and only natural hair colours are permissible.
Valuables	such as mobile phones, tablets, games etc are not necessary in school.

**PE** navy shorts, t-shirt in team colour (either with school logo or plain), pumps or trainers. Navy tracksuit (for outdoors in cooler weather)

Swimming conventional swimwear (no long shorts for boys) and towel. Swimming caps for girls are encouraged. Children wearing earrings will not be allowed to swim (CMBC policy)
