# **Reception**

### Year 2


Will continue with addition and subtraction up to 100 before moving onto multiplication and division

## English:

Reception and Year I will continue with Talk Through Stories— Can't you sleep little bear.


The year 1's will begin to complete SPAG lessons building on knowledge of sentence structures.

Year 2 will complete work on Lost and Found including creasting a lost poster and writing their own instructions to make a penguin.

## Science:

Living things and their environment

The children will begin to understand the difference between things that are alive, things that are dead and things that are inanimate (have never been alive). The children will begin to ask questions about the differences between these things will help children to think scientifically They will build on knowledge of different types of animals as they learn about habitats including rainforests, deserts, meadows and underground habitats.



# PSHE Safety and the changing body

The children will learn how to stay safe on the internet and what to do if something makes them feel uncomfortable.

## Art—Painting and mixed media

The children will learn the primary and secondary colours, colour mixing, and creating textures using different tools. They will also cover collage techniques, encouraging to experiment with materials and evaluate their artistic choices.
